Veterans

Veterans play a 9-hole single Stableford every Monday. Tee off times are 7.00 am – 8.30 am and 11.30 am – 1.00 pm.

All players are to be over 55 for men and 50 for *Ladies*. Players must be affiliated with NSW Veteran Golfers Association (Inc), which is an annual fee of \$3.30 paid to the Club's Secretary/Manager.

Veterans play off their club handicap when first playing and then the handicap is altered to the club veteran's handicap as follows:

Win a ball	Lose 1 stroke
Score 20 points or more	Lose 1 stroke per point over par
Do not win a ball	Gain 1 stroke

Men players can go out to a handicap of 52 and *Ladies* to a handicap of 54

For the annual 18-hole tournament all players will play off their AGU handicap.

Juniors' Golf

The Wagga Wagga Country Club and its members recognise that the development of Junior Golf within the Club environment is vital to the ongoing success and viability of the Club. The aims of the program are:

To promote our Club and the sport of golf to *juniors* (both male and female).

To provide access to Club facilities at an affordable cost to *juniors* who wish to learn to play golf and to participate in Club activities.

To provide tuition in the fundamental skills of golf.

To provide instruction on golf etiquette and respect for the golf course.

To explain in theoretical and practical terms, the rules of Golf and their effect.

To provide a Structured Beginners Competition, specifically designed for *juniors* to improve and learn throughout the year.

To facilitate access to coaching clinics, external golf competitions and promotions.

To develop and prepare *juniors* for membership and full playing status in senior club competitions.

Juniors are encouraged to have fun and enjoy the sport, the beauty of our golf course and the friendships made with other junior golfers.

Parents (uncles, aunts, brothers, sisters) are welcome to join in and walk or play the course during Sunday competitions. Contact John Bittar on 0409 880 002 for more information.

Juniors' Golf Program

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS - This is an Honour Board Event Played over two Sundays of 18 holes and is open to all junior players with a **Junior Competition Handicap**.

Eligibility to play in this event is based on the junior holding a current Junior Golf Program (ie Sunday junior competition) handicap, and participation in the regular Sunday junior competition.

Note: Junior competition handicaps only remain current for two months, after which a new handicap must be gained.

Additionally, **at least three individual cards must be completed in the regular Sunday junior competition within the two month period** prior to the championships.

Players are eligible to win only one major prize. This is the highest category of prize for which he or she qualifies. For example, a place in the scratch event is higher than the same place in the handicap event.

Grant Wealands Memorial Trophy. This event is for the most improved official AGU or LGU junior handicap player over the 2009 year (up to the scheduled club championships).

Tom Hillis Junior Golf Foundation

Due to the generosity of our Club members, and Tom Hillis in particular, a fund has been formed to support and encourage junior golf members.

Types of assistance funding that is considered by the foundation are outlined in the NSWGA funding and scholarships for amateur golfers and include the following:

- Coaching costs, including tuition fees, travel and living expenses
- Travelling and living costs incurred at approved golfing events
- Golf equipment (including any clothing worn on a golf course)
- Medical treatment,(eg physiotherapy) specifically affecting the playing of golf

Application forms can be obtained through the Junior Coordinator or Secretary/Manager and 30 days notice should be given prior to the event.

Members' General Information

DRESS AND CONDUCT

Members shall observe proper dress and orderly conduct within the clubhouse. The suitability or otherwise of a member's attire depends on the particular occasion and there should be no need to instruct members on this point. However, for your guidance, the following points are stressed:

1. T-shirts with slogans or wording, football socks, or board shorts are not acceptable dress
2. Long dress socks or sport socks are to be worn with shorts
3. Dress jeans may be acceptable dress in the Clubhouse, whilst recognising that they are fashionable. It is required that they, like any form of apparel, be neat and tidy.

Members are expected to abide by these rules and assist in implementing them.

DRESS ON COURSE

Players on the golf course must be properly attired. The wearing of thongs, sandals or rippled soled shoes is not allowed. Shorts are only permitted when worn with dress socks or sport socks. *Ladies* must be neatly dressed at all times. Short shorts, tight jeans, sun tops and sundresses are not permitted.

Shoes with metal spikes are not allowed.

Time Sheets

Time sheets are available in the Pro Shop or the clubhouse. Any member who is unable to play when drawn must notify the starter; otherwise latecomers will be relegated to the end of the field. All social groups must hit off in their allotted times.

TEE-OFF TIME

All players must report to the Pro Shop 15 minutes before tee-off time. The time stated on the time sheet is the tee-off time NOT the arrival time.

ELECTION OF MEMBERS

It cannot be stressed enough the great responsibility a member assumes when proposing a candidate for admission to our Club, and the nominator MUST have a thorough knowledge of the person concerned.

A notice will be displayed on the Notice board for at least fourteen (14) days showing the names of candidates for admission to the club, together with the names of nominators. Members therefore have an opportunity and are requested to lodge their comments either for or against admission of the candidate.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.

No players shall play until the players in front are out of range.

In the interest of all golfers, players should play without delay.

Players searching for a ball should allow other players coming up to pass them; they should signal the players following them to pass, and should not continue their play until those players have passed and are out of range.

Before leaving a bunker a player should carefully rake and fill all holes.

Through the green a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced is replaced at once and pressed down. A sand bucket **MUST** be carried at all times and used to repair divots.

Players should ensure that when dropping the flagstick no damage is done to the putting green, and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to the hole, in handling the flagsticks, or in removing the ball from the hole. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before players leave the putting green. When the result of a hole has been determined, players should immediately leave the putting area.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

In the absence of special rules, two-ball matches should have precedence over and be entitled to pass any three or four-ball match. A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind.

Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.

If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.

GROUND STAFF ON COURSE

Ground Staff have right of way while working on all areas of the course. Please give sufficient time so that staff may move machinery and themselves out of the line of play. Under no circumstances are members to direct complaints directly to the ground staff. All complaints should go through the appropriate channels.

RULES OF COMPETITION PLAY

Play is under the conditions determined by the match Sub-Committee, in compliance with the Rules of Golf as authorised by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, and **local rules** in operation at the time.

Before commencing play, members should inspect the Notice Board for temporary local rules and other information.

To be eligible to play competition, players must enter their names on the sheet provided and pay entrance fee before the commencement of their round, at the Pro shop.

Tee times must be observed at all times. All players must report to the Pro shop at least 15 minutes before hit-of time.

If unable to play please remove your name from the time sheet or notify the Pro shop. The Pro Shop controls the time on the actual day of play.

Do not hand in your card until you have checked your score and counter-signed the card. All competitors' cards **MUST** be returned immediately on completion of play.

Always pick up when you have lost a hole to par or exhausted strokes allowed in Stableford.

Repair all lob marks on the green - you are allowed to do this prior to putting.

Always play without delay: walk briskly between shots. Remember there are players behind you who also wish to complete their round.

The maximum number of players in any one group shall be four players. During competition play ONLY, the committee may vary these numbers.

Each player must have his or her own clubs.

Applications of Handicaps to Various Competitions

Stroke: Full Handicap

Par and Stableford: Full Handicap

Four Ball Best Ball: Stroke Par and Stableford Full Handicap

Foursomes: Two players play as partners and use one ball. The partners strike off alternately from the tee and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play of each hole until holed out. $\frac{1}{2}$ aggregate stroke handicap.

Mixed Foursomes: Played in the same manner as foursomes except that the *Ladies* use their own tees and observe their own local rules when it is their turn to play. $\frac{1}{2}$ aggregate stroke handicap.

Canadian Foursomes: Played as above except that both players play tee shots at every hole and afterwards continue with whichever ball they nominate. Half aggregate stroke handicap for men and $\frac{3}{8}$ of combined stroke handicap for *Ladies*.

American Foursomes: Both players play tee shots at each hole, and then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Half of aggregate stroke handicap for men and $\frac{3}{8}$ of combined stroke handicap for *Ladies*.

Ambrose: Played with one or more partners. Each player tees off; the better position of the balls is marked. Players in succession, and in any sequence, place their ball within one club length of this position (no nearer to the hole) and play. The handicap will be $\frac{1}{8}$ of the combined handicap if a

group of four, $\frac{1}{4}$ if a group of two. Fractional handicaps are to be used.

COUNT-BACK SYSTEM

Deciding Ties in Events

Ties in events shall be decided whenever possible by replay, but if the Committee considers this to be inexpedient the following count-back method shall be used:

1. For 18-hole events the best score for the last 9 holes shall be used; if there is still a tie the last six holes, or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 18th.
2. In 27 hole events the first 18 holes shall be used; if still tied the last 9 holes and then as for No 1 above.
3. In 36, 54, and 72-hole events the last 18 holes shall be used and still tied count back as in 1 above.
4. In handicap events the relevant handicap or fraction thereof shall be applied.

NOTES

- a. For a 9-hole event the best score for the last six holes shall be used, if there is still a tie the last three holes, if a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 9th hole.
- b. In all cases, the last holes are as per the scorecard, not necessarily as played.

STABLEFORD SYSTEM OF SCORING

Competitors take the strokes they receive at the allotted holes. Mark at each hole the number of strokes actually taken.

Hole done in net one over par	1 point
Hole done in net par	2 points
Hole done in net one under par	3 points
Hole done in net two under par	4 points
Hole done in net three under par	5 points

The competitor with the highest total of points is the winner.

Men's Condition of Play

Responsibility in Play: The lowest handicap player in any group will be responsible for proper observance of course etiquette, replacing divots and inviting following players through. Should two players be on equally low handicaps, they will mutually arrange who will accept responsibility.

Competition Grades:

Ten (10) players constitute a competition.

10 to 29 players constitute 'A' grade only.

30 to 60 players constitute 'A' and 'B' grades.

61 or more players constitute 'A', 'B' and 'C' grades.

2 Grades

A Grade 0-15

B Grade 16-36

Handicap Gradings: Club Competitions

'A' Grade 0-12

'B' Grade 13-18

'C' Grade 19-36

Handicap Gradings: Open Competitions

'A' Grade 0-12

'B' Grade 13-18

'C' Grade 19-27

Competitions and Club handicap gradings may be altered at the discretion of the Committee.

MEN'S EVENTS – CONDITIONS

Club Championships Single Stroke event played over 72 holes. Best scratch winners for Club Champion, B Grade Champion, C Grade Champion, Junior Champion (Under 18 at time of event.)

Veteran Champion (55 years and over at time of event)

Denniston Wedge – Eclectic competition to all players during the Club Championships. Lowest scratch score on each hole is recorded through the four rounds. Winner decided on lowest total for 18 holes.

4BBB Championships. Pair's event played over 36 holes

Winners in both scratch & Handicap

4BBB Mixed 18 holes

Glynwylln Cup Medal of Medals – The 12 monthly medal winners in each grade compete for the three medals. The final is played in conjunction with the 3rd round of the Club Championships.

Monthly Medal – Single stroke event played first Saturday of each month. Net winner in each grade receives an engraved glass mug. The Hillis Ford monthly medal, single Stableford event is played the first Wednesday of each month. The highest score of a player, who is in attendance at the presentation, wins the monthly mug. The winner receives a complimentary drinks voucher to the value of \$25.00 courtesy of Hillis Ford.

Jack Daniels – Gentleman Jack 4BBB Aggregate. On the third Wednesday of each month, the best two individual scores in each four qualify for the team aggregate. Teams must enter their own scores at the Pro shop. The winner is the best team aggregate score still in the club house at presentations. The winning team will each receive a bottle of Gentleman Jack, courtesy of Jack Daniels. Players must be over 18 to be eligible.

R L Smith Matchplay Championships – Single scratch event. Top 8 players in each grade from Club Championships form a draw.

All sudden-death rounds over 18 holes except final which is over 36 holes.


Summer Cup – Pairs BB handicap matchplay

Top 8 pairs from qualifier in January form draw

All sudden-death rounds over 18 holes except final which is over 36 holes

Dr Tyrie Trophy – Single handicap matchplay championships. Top 16 net qualifiers from August monthly medal form draw. All sudden-death rounds over 18 holes except final which is over 36 holes.

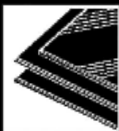
