

## LOCAL RULES

*(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)*

- 1. Out of Bounds.** Those areas beyond the course boundary fences.
- 2. Staked or Ornamental Trees.** If a tree or shrub which is staked interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 24-b(i) (Immovable Obstructions)
- 3. All Stakes and Tree Guards are Immovable Obstructions.**
- 4. Power Lines and/or Poles.** If a ball strikes a power line, pole or associated equipment, the ball **MUST** be replayed without penalty.
- 5. Ground Under Repair.**
  - (a) All areas defined by white stakes and/or lines.
  - (b) Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.
  - (c) Constructed pathways are G.U.R.
- 6. Compulsory Ground under repair.**
  - (a) 9th hole: All areas west to the line on practise fairway, car park and clubhouse area (including garden beds and paths).
  - (b) 17th hole: All areas south of the northern edge of bitumen road or the clubhouse (including garden beds and paths).
- 7. Distance indicators** are measured to centre of green.

### PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

*Match Play - Loss of Hole.*

*Stroke Play - 2 Strokes.*
